

## A STUDY TOUR TO SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA

(6-Day Program on Academic, Research, and Career Opportunities)

### About the Program:

Internationally engineers are in high demand! This study tour is designed for students who are on the journey to becoming engineers and interested in understanding how the profession is being developed in other countries. Travelling to Singapore and Malaysia, students will have the opportunity to visit a range of academic institutions and the departments where engineering is taught. During their time at the institutions, students will be given a tour of the engineer laboratories, possibly attend a university lecture and have the opportunity to interact with local engineering students. Through the planned activities, students will have the opportunity to explore academic, research and career opportunities, as graduate engineers, outside of India.
